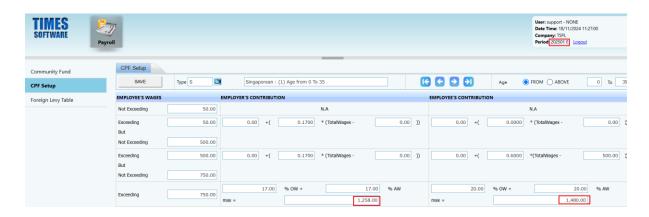
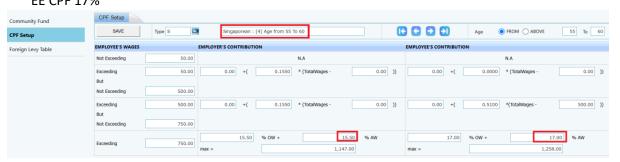

- 1. CPF changes in 2025 (Check before process 202501 Payroll)
 - a. CPF Ordinary Wage ceiling increases to \$7400

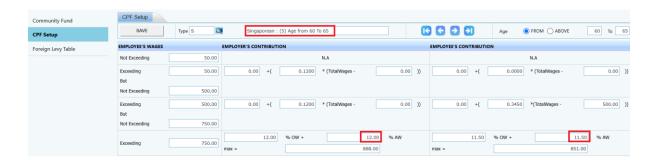
Max EE CPF \$7400 x 20% = \$1480 Max ER CPF \$7400 x 17% = \$1258



b. CPF contribution rates changes for employees aged above 55 to 60
 ER CPF 15.5%
 EE CPF 17%



CPF contribution rates changes for employees aged above 60 to 65
 ER CPF 12%
 EE CPF 11.5%



2. Government-Paid Paternity Leave (GPPL) changes

From **1** April **2025**, eligible working fathers will be entitled to **4** weeks of GOVERNMENT-PAID PATERNITY LEAVE (GPPL).

3. Shared Parental Leave (SPL) changes

From **1 April 2025**, new Shared Parental Leave (SPL) scheme will replace current scheme. The new scheme comprises 10 weeks of paid parental leave, shared between both parents. It will be implemented in two phases:

- From 1 April 2025: 6 weeks of shared parental leave
- From 1 April 2026: 10 weeks of shared parental leave

The 10 weeks of leave is provided on top of GPML and GPPL entitlements.

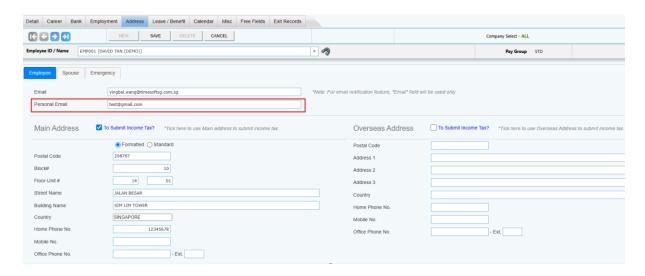
